

2024 MPFR MARKET LIVESTOCK WEIGHTS

BEEF: Minimum Weight 950 lbs. No Maximum Weight

SWINE: Minimum Weight 225 lbs. Maximum Weight 295 lbs.

SHEEP: Minimum Weight 100 lbs. No Maximum Weight

GOAT: Minimum Weight 55 lbs. No Maximum Weight

TURKEYS: Weight for Hens 13-30 lbs. Weight for Toms 19-30 lbs.

POULTRY (Fryer Pen): Minimum Weight 3.5 lbs. Maximum Weight 7 lbs.

POULTRY (Broiler Pen): Minimum Weight 7lbs. Maximum Weight 12 lbs.

GEESE: Minimum Weight 12 lbs.

DUCKS: Minimum Weight 4 lbs.

RABBITS: Minimum Weight 3.5 lbs. Maximum Weight 5.5 lbs.



Don't forget that we have a portable scale (sheep, goat and swine) so you can weigh your livestock projects frequently and make sure they are on track for fair! Just call the office for availability. You must provide transportation of the scale.




