#### 2024-2025 Grand County 4-H Mini Grant Application

Applications may also be delivered to the CSU Extension Office in Kremmling.

Applications will be signed off by member's 4-H Club Leader or Council Advisor, reviewed by the Grand County CSU Extension Office Staff, and presented for approval to Middle Park 4-H Council.

Applications must be received in the Extension Office by **January 31, 2025**. Successful applicants will be notified by **February 7, 2025**. These deadlines are an effort to get awards to members earlier in the 4-H year.

#### Guidelines:

- 1. Mini Grants are available for Grand County 4-H members, 8-18 years of age (4-H age), in good standing with their 4-H Club and the Grand County CSU Extension Office.
- 2. This 4-H mini grant can be used to support the cost to complete a project(s) in: Animals/Creative Arts/Family Consumer Science/Natural Resources/Personal Development/STEM.
- 3. Priority of available dollars will go to the individual 4-H members first, then 4-H Clubs and 4-H Council requests.
- 4. An individual 4-H member request may not exceed \$250.00/4-H Member.
- 5. Grand County 4-H Clubs, and Middle Park 4-H Council, are encouraged to apply for funds that will support educational opportunities for 4-H club members, the Middle Park 4-H community, or Grand County community. Examples of opportunities for the mini grants are; host a 4-H clinic or workshop, attend an educational field trip, put on a community service event, etc. A 4-H club or council request may not exceed \$1,000/club or council.
- 6. **Members and clubs may not request the following items or item types:** ammunition, firearms, or arrows. Mini-grant funds may not be used for age restricted purchases, the items must be able to be purchased by the member themselves.
- 7. Recipients of the grant will be required to submit a minimum of 2 photos; the first must include how the dollars received have been utilized and the second should be a photo of the final project or event.

- 8. All grant recipients are required to submit a final report, typically in the form of a survey, on how the funds were used, the success of the project, and benefits to the community. **This is required!** Should this report not be submitted, the 4-H member, 4- H Club, or 4-H Council will not be eligible to apply for the mini grant again the following year, and must return mini-grant funds.
- 9. The deadline for completion of all required documentation is **September 12<sup>th</sup>**, **2025.** No exceptions shall be made.
- 10. Any remaining grant dollars must be returned to the Middle Park 4-H Council.
- 11. If a 4-H member has an incomplete in the project for which they requested funds for, they will not be allowed to request grant money again for this project, for one full 4-H year, and the grant money must be returned in full.
- 12. If a member would like to change their application due to an add/drop of projects, they must communicate with the Extension Office to submit a Change Request form.
- 13. Misuse of grant funds, not outlined in the application, must be returned in full and the applicant cannot request grant money in the future.

#### How to Apply:

- 1. Complete the Mill Mini Grant Application. Please answer the questions completely.
- 2. All applications must have a 4-H Club Leader or Council Advisor signature, and applicant signature to be considered.
- 3. Submit completed application to Grand County CSU Extension Office by January 31st, 4:00pm.

## After Applying:

- 1. Successful applicants will be notified by February 7<sup>th</sup>. This date is dependent on the February Middle Park Council meeting. In the event the meeting is rescheduled, applicants will be notified by March 7<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. Pending approval by Middle Park 4-H Council, grant checks will be disbursed within one month.
- 3. The Grand County CSU Extension Office will provide grant recipients an instruction packet that details deadlines and documents described in the application guidelines at the time of the award notification.
